- Submitting all documentation (e.g., session notes, time sheets, etc.) in a timely manner
- Communicating case management concerns with the BCBA, and the Clinical Director
- Being responsible to the needs and requests of clients, their families, and supervisors
- Arriving on time and being prepared for therapy sessions
- Maintaining confidentiality of clients at all times.
- Providing services that are effective, efficient, and ethical and maintain professionalism in all aspects of your work

- Bachelor's degree in Special Education, Education, Psychology or a related field is preferred, (undergraduates with experience will be considered)
